## DATE AND VENUE

The Conference will be held from Monday, September 27<sup>th</sup>, to Thursday, September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2004, at the **Chamber of Commerce of the Republic of Serbia, 15 Resavska street, Belgrade, Serbia & Montenegro.**

## CONFERENCE LANGUAGE

The official language of the Conference is English. No simultaneous translation shall be provided.

## SCIENTIFIC SESSIONS

The scientific sessions will be held in **the conference hall** (oral presentations) and in **the entrance hall** (posters). Personal computer with video beam for Power Point presentations and overhead projector for the transparencies will be available.

The sessions will focus on the topics of current interest given in the announcement. Oral presentations of invited and selected speakers will present general aspects of the Conference. Due to limited time and great interest, other accepted contributions will be presented as posters. Posters' dimensions are 80 cm x 120 cm.

## POSTERS

Due to limited space, two poster sessions will run for two full days each.

**Poster Session (A, B, and C)**, the authors are kindly requested to put up their posters on Monday (September 27<sup>th</sup>) before 08:30 and remove them on Tuesday (September 28<sup>th</sup>) after the poster review session (at 18:30).

**Poster Session (D, E, F, and G)**, the posters are to be put up on Wednesday (September 29<sup>th</sup>) before 08:30 and removed on Thursday (September 30<sup>th</sup>) after the poster review session (at 11:30).

**Poster review and discussion** will be held on Tuesday (September 28<sup>th</sup>) at 17:30 and Thursday (September 30<sup>th</sup>) at 10:30.

Authors are requested to be present at their posters at least during the breaks of oral sessions.
